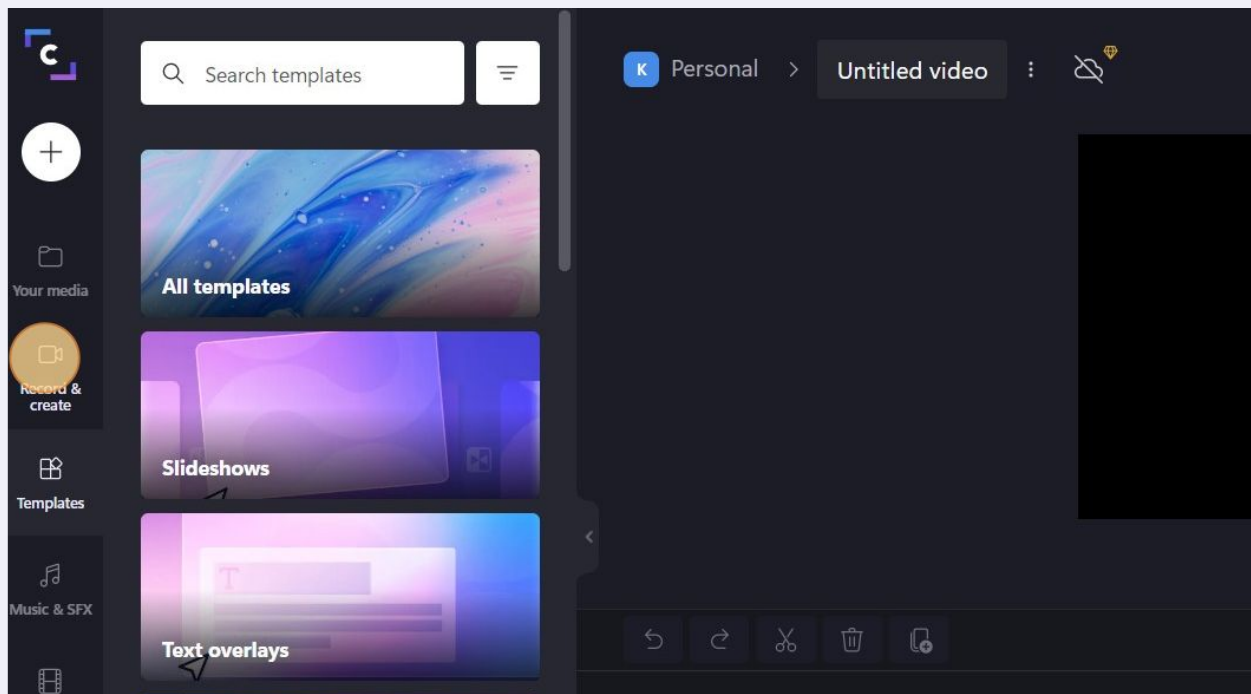


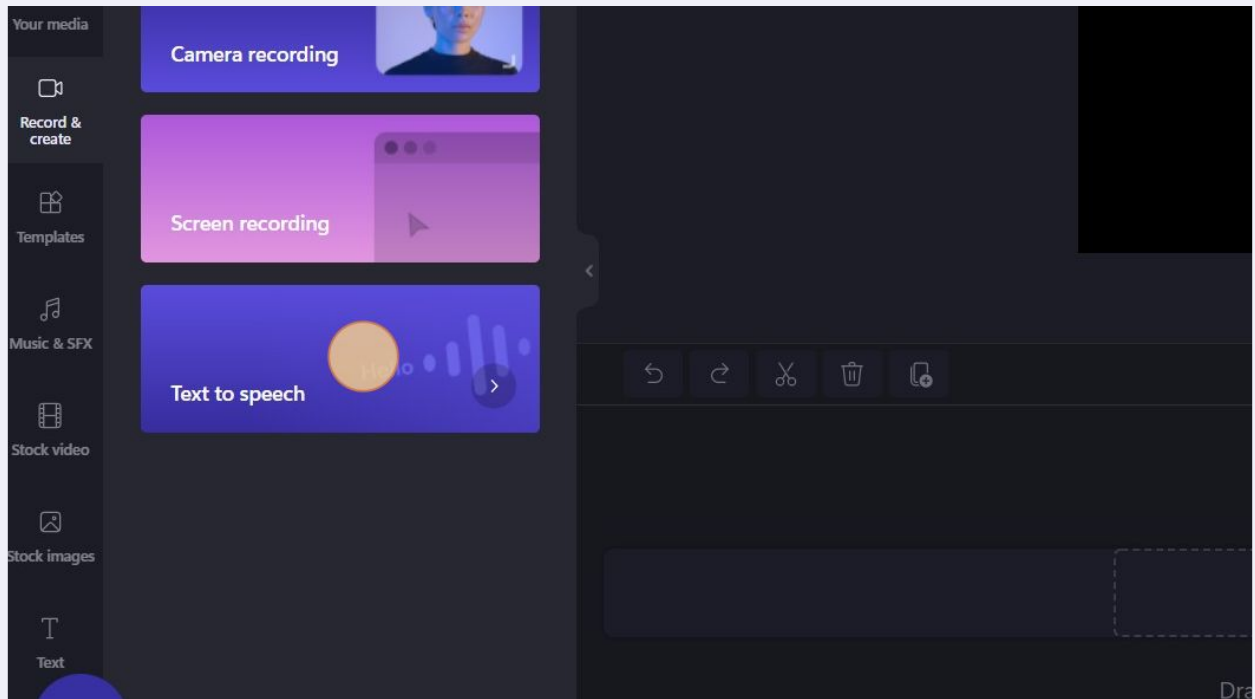
Clipchamp Workflow

1 Navigate to <https://app.clipchamp.com/editor/>

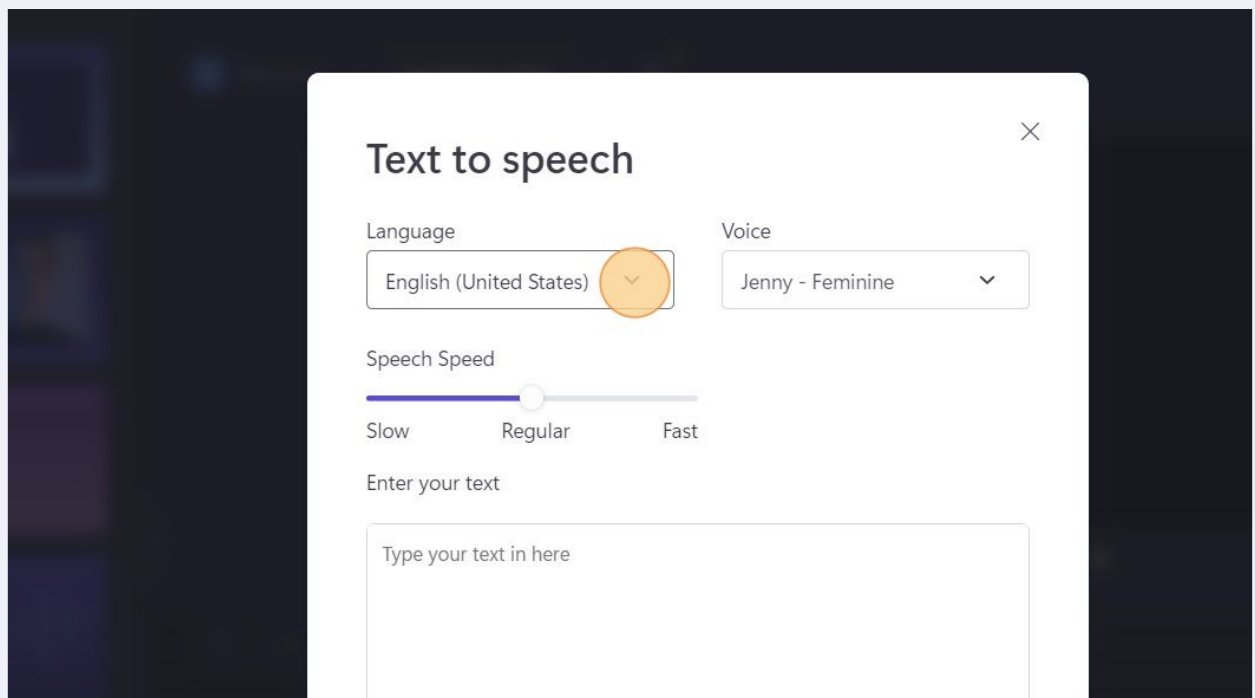
2 Click the Record and create button



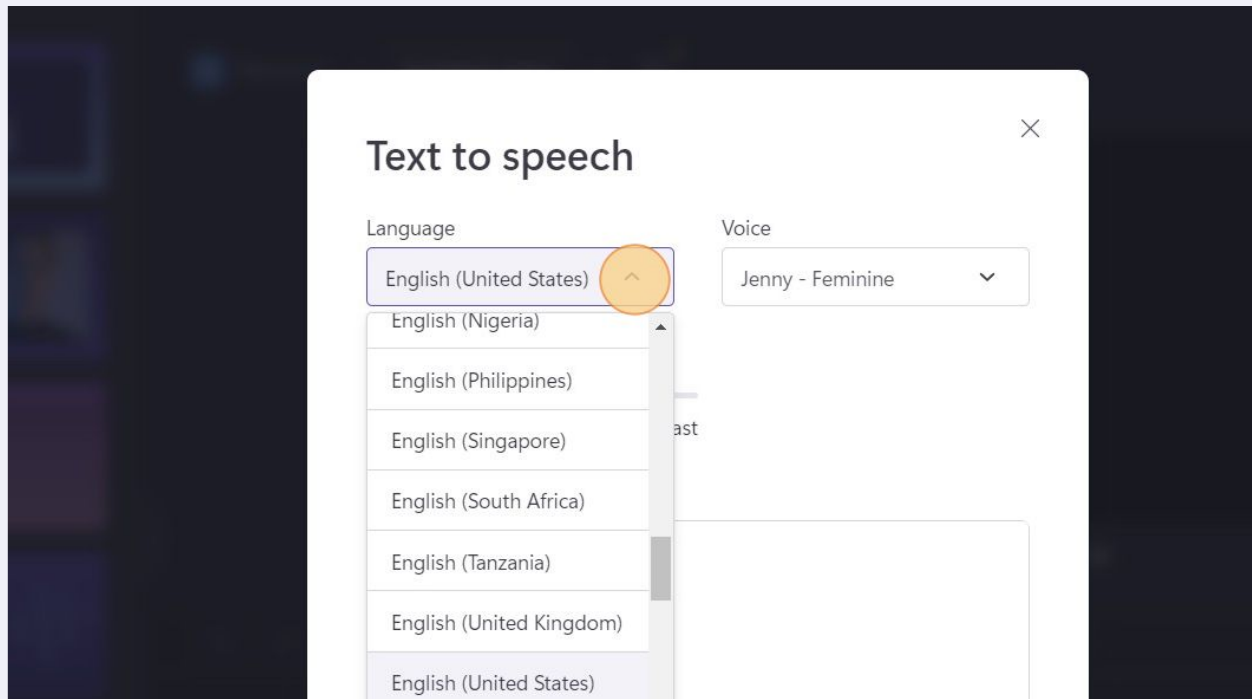
3 Click Text to speech.



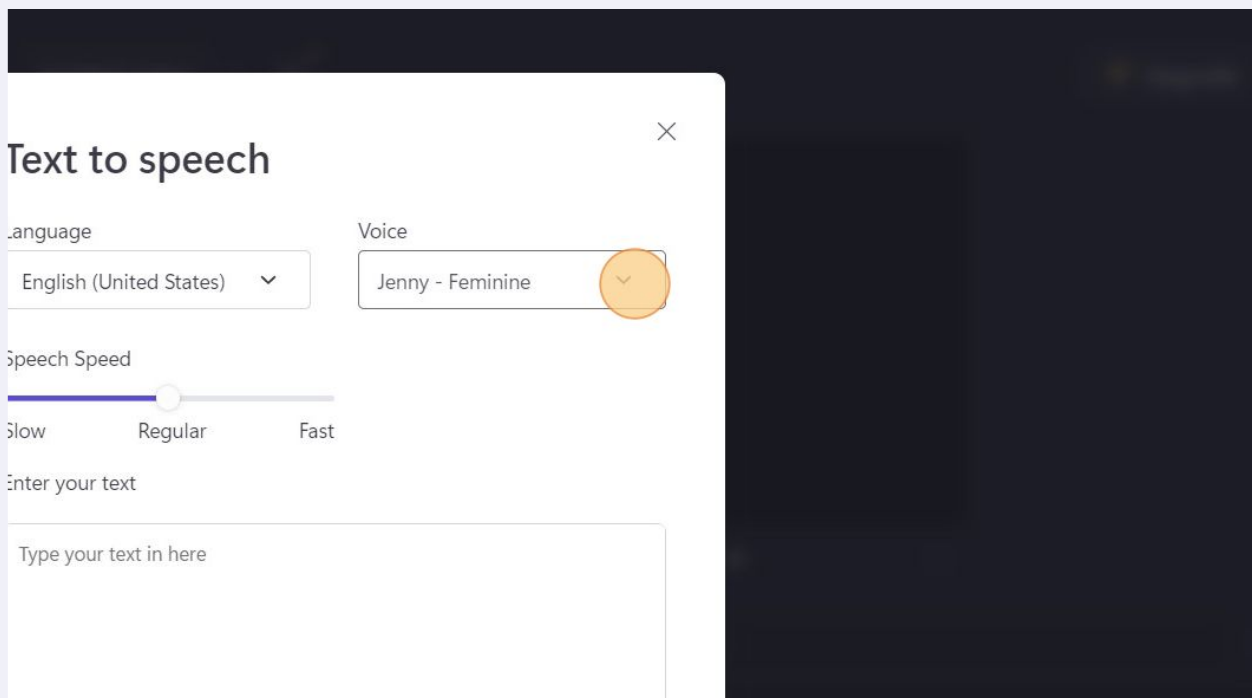
4 Click this icon to select Language.



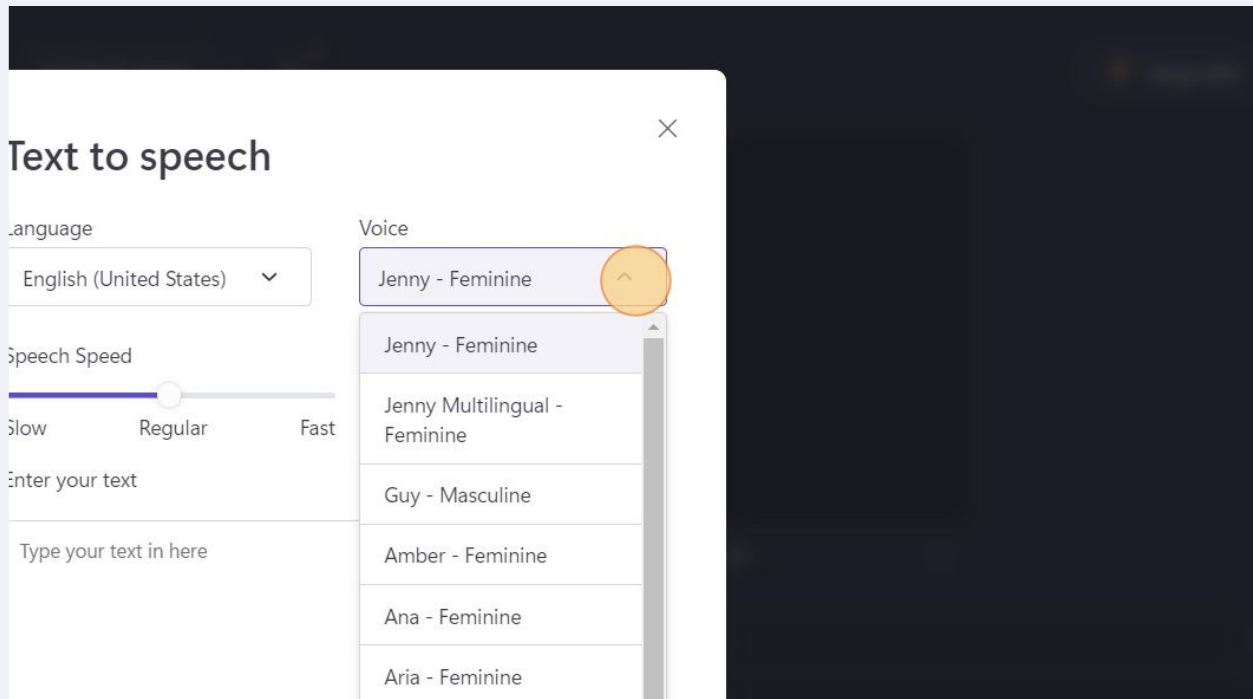
5 Select language from drop down.



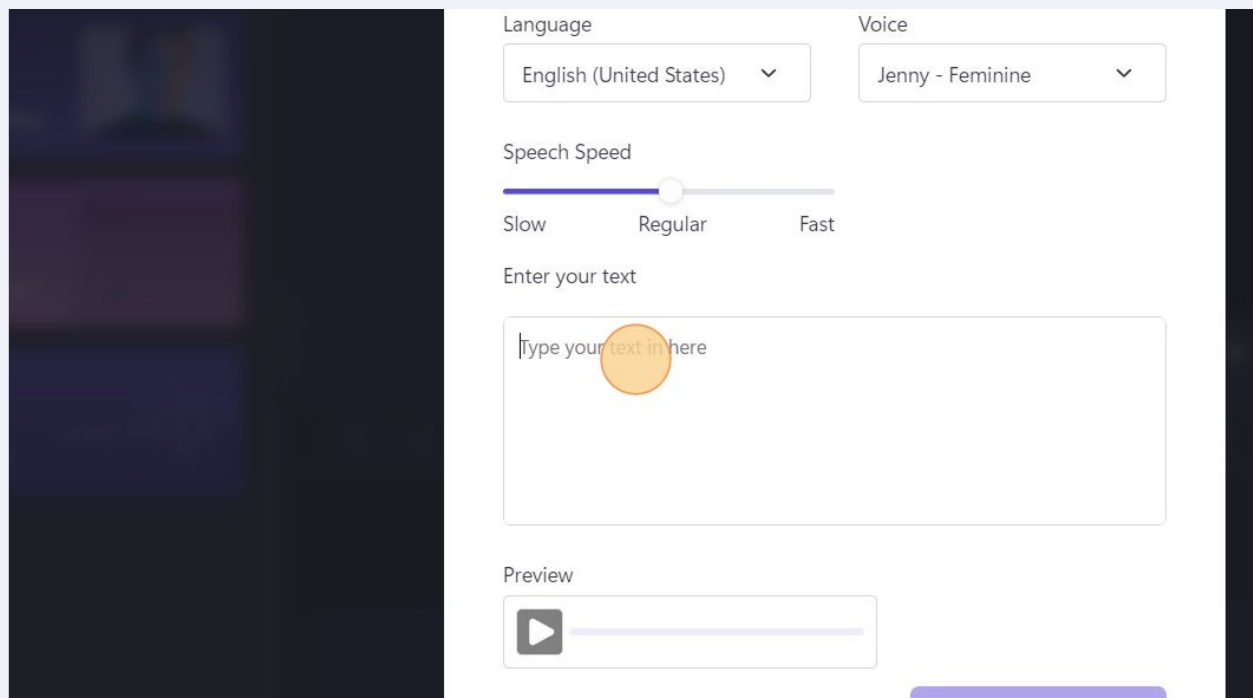
6 Click this icon to select Voice.




7 Select a voice from the drop down.



8 Click the "Type your text in here" field.




9 Paste and/or type your text here.



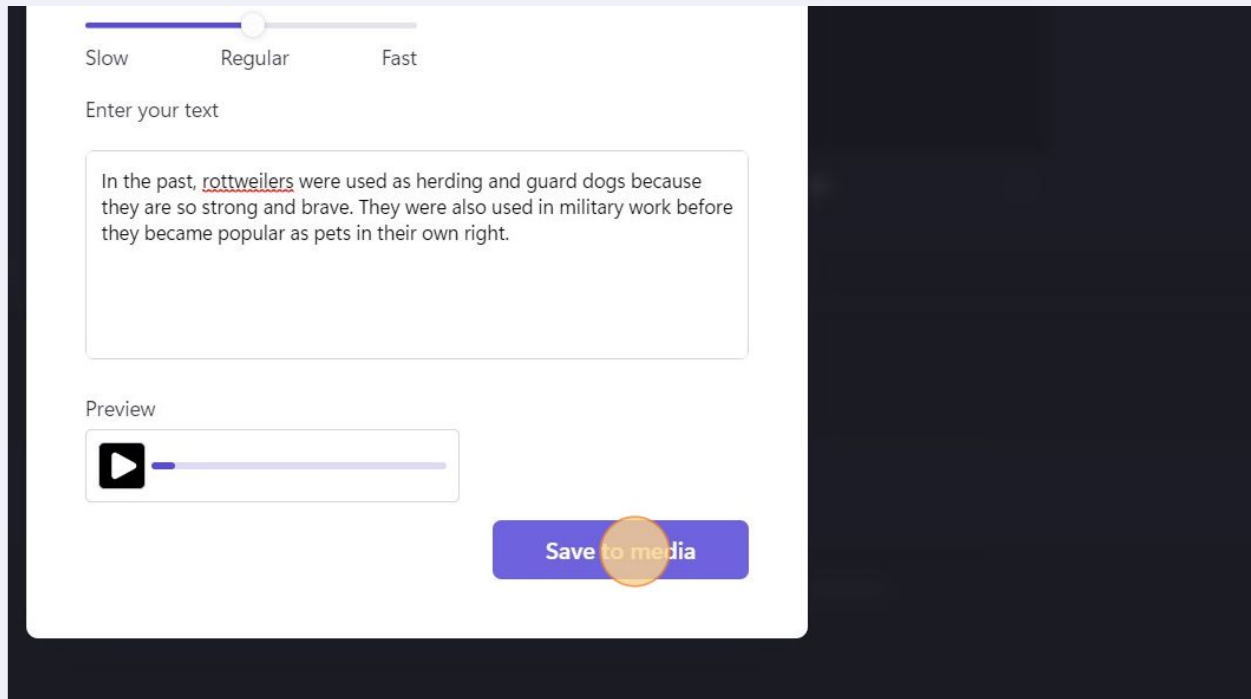

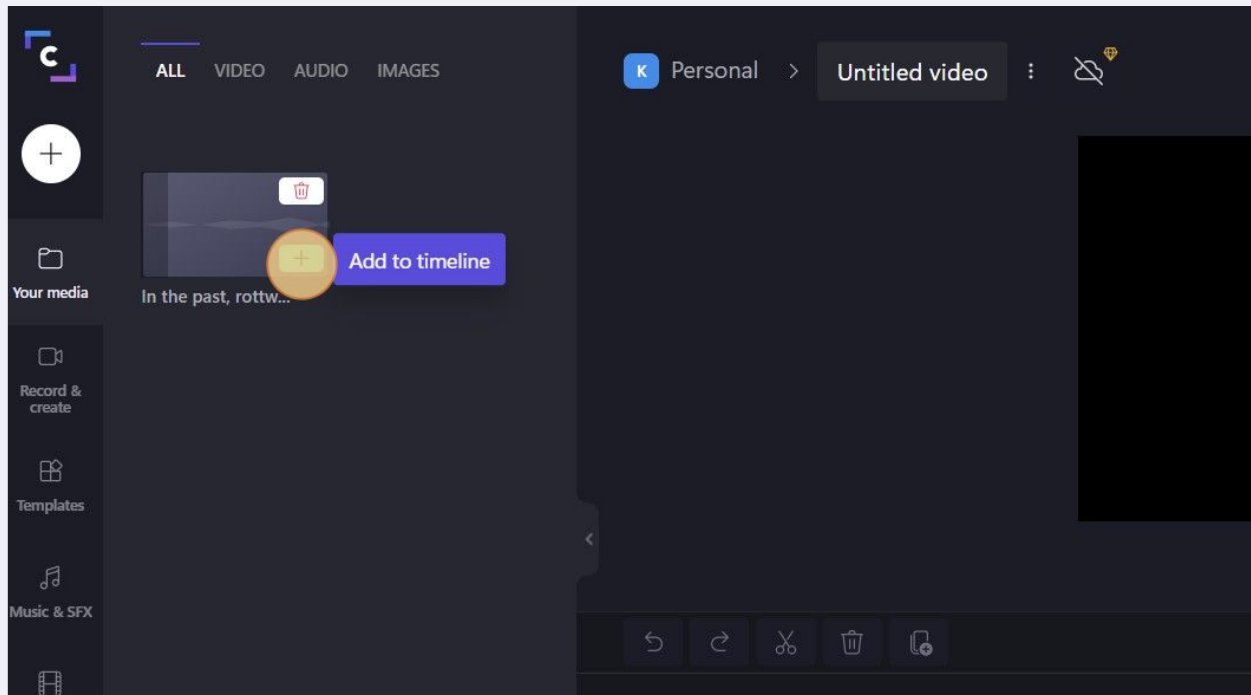

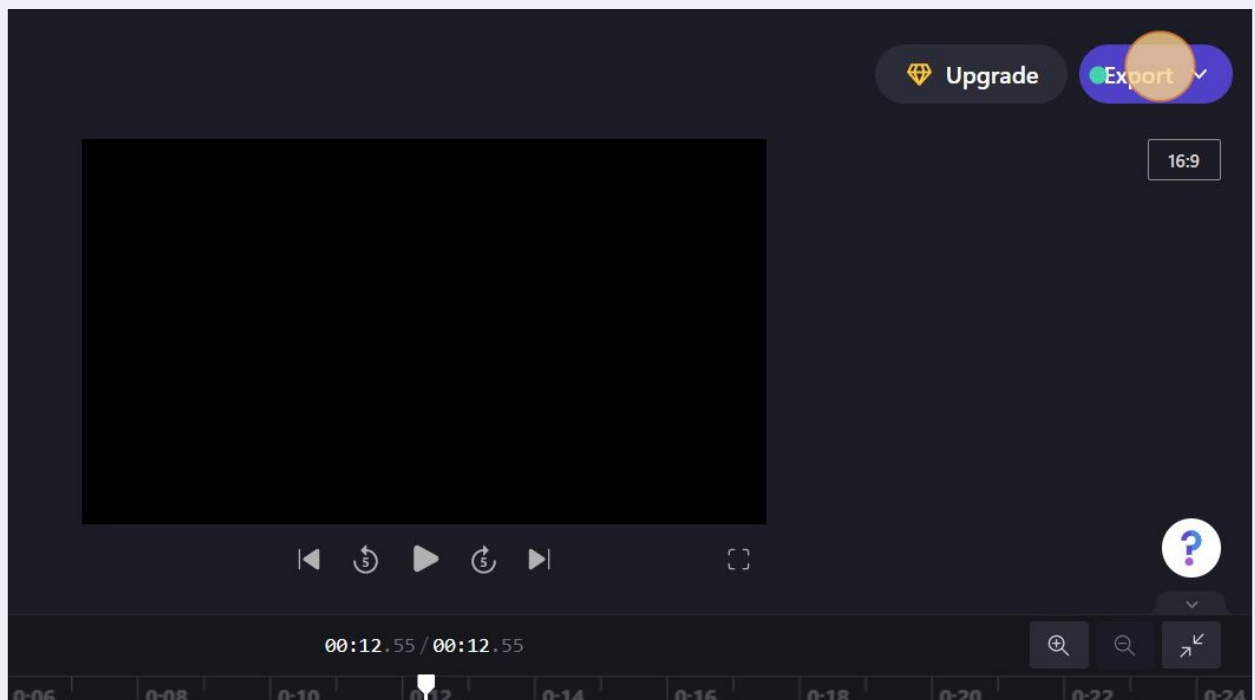
12 The voice over was added to the media bin. Click here. to add it to the video time line.
